ORDER:

In the circumstances mentioned by the Advocate General of Tamil Nadu in the reference second read above, the Government, after careful examination, order the following amendment, to the G.O.Ms.No.1003, Public (LO) Department, dated 26.08.2008; which shall be incorporated after the end of paragraph 2 in the above said G.O.

"It is also ordered that the Departments in Secretariat shall address the Advocate General / Additional Advocate General concerned as per the above allocation to obtain the opinion on cases emanating from the respective Departments, so as to facilitate early settling of opinion and to reduce delay substantially. If the departments address Advocate General for opinion the Advocate General is authorized to refer the
