ORDER:

In the G.O. third read above orders were issued appointing Thiru G.Sankaran as Special Government Pleader (Education) in the High Court of Madras to attend all cases before the High court of Madras in the matter of cases relating to Education including Medical Education.

2. In the G.O. Second read above orders were issued that all the posts of Special Government Pleaders both in the High Court of Madras and its Bench at Madurai, except in respect of subjects namely Taxes, Education and HR &CE, shall merely be designated as 'Special Government Pleaders'. The Government Pleader, High Court of Madras has been authorized to allocate work, in consultation with the Advocate General of Tamil Nadu to various Law Officers both in the High Court of Madras as well as in its Madurai Bench considering the exigency of the situation.

In the circumstances mentioned in the letter fourth read above, the Government, after careful consideration, accept the proposal of the Director General of Police / Chairman, Tamil Nadu Uniformed Services Recruitment Board, Chennai and authorize Thiru G. Sankaran Special Government Pleader (Education) to appear on behalf of the Government in all cases arising out of the recruitment of Police Personnel from the Tamil Nadu Uniformed Services Recruitment Board and the Office of the Director General of Police and that of the Government filed before the High Court of Madras as well as before the Madurai Bench of High Court of Madras.
