ORDER :

The Government have decided to appoint a Committee to assess the damages caused to the properties and injuries to the persons during the incidents of Law and Order that occurred in and around the campus of the High Court of Madras, Chennai-104 on 19.02.2009 and 20.02.2009.

2. The Government, therefore, accord sanction to the constitution of a Committee consisting of the following members:-

1. Hon'ble Justice Thiru K Gnanaprakasam,
Retired High Court Judge.
2. Thiru R.Poornalingam, I.A.S. (Retired)
3. Thiru P.Rajendran, I.P.S. (Retired)
4. The Chief Engineer (Buildings), PWD, Chennai-5

Hon'ble Justice Thiru K.Gnanaprakasam, Retired High Court Judge, shall be the Chairman of the Committee.

3. The terms of reference of the Committee shall be as follows, namely:-

- i) To assess and record the extent and monetary value of the damages caused to the public and private properties both movable and immovable, connected with the Law and Order incidents that occurred in and around the campus of the High Court, Chennai on 19th and 20th February 2009.

- ii) To assess and record the injuries sustained by the Lawyers, Staff of High Court and Subordinate Courts, Police personnel, litigants and the public if any, connected with the Law and Order incidents that occurred in and around the campus of the High Court, Chennai on 19th and 20th February 2009.
- iii) To suggest the quantum of compensation to be paid if any, in respect of items (i) and (ii) above.
- iv) To make any other recommendations as the Committee deems fit in respect of the above incident.

4. The Committee will complete its inquiry and submit report to the Government within a period of one month from the date of the first meeting of the Committee.

5. Due to the special nature of the Committee and the sensitivity and urgency of the work to be carried out by the Committee, it shall be provided with necessary staff and other logistical support.
