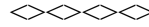

Sub: Political Pension – Sanction of Freedom Fighter Family Pension to those who are in receipt of civil family pension – Clarification sought for – Reg.

2. From the Treasury Officer, Virudhunagar, Letter of even No 11900/2004/ E3 dated 25.2.2005 and 18.7.2005.



I am directed to invite your attention to the reference first cited in which the Accountant General, Chennai-18 has raised the issue of admissibility of Freedom Fighters Family Pension to the dependents who are already in receipt of civil family pension.

2. In this connection I am directed to inform that Tamil Nadu Pension Rules 1978 have been amended in Government Order Ms.No.23, Finance (Pension) Department, dated 6.1.1996 and the following sub rule (13-B) has been inserted:-

“(13-B) Family pension admissible under this rule shall not be granted to a person who is already in receipt of family pension or is eligible therefor under any other pension rules:

Provided that a person, who is otherwise eligible for family pension under this rule, may opt to receive family pension under this rule if he forgoes family pension admissible from any other rules.”

3. I am therefore directed to request you to ensure that payment of Freedom Fighters Family Pension is in accordance with the above rule.
