### ORDER:

In the G.O first read above, orders have been issued according administrative sanction for the implementation of the Emergency Tsunami Reconstruction Project with World Bank assistance at a cost of Rs.1852.74 crores for Housing reconstruction, Restoration of livelihood, repairs/reconstruction of public buildings, providing technical assistance and training and implement support for tsunami affected victims and buildings.

2) In the G.O second read above the Government have constituted an Empowered Committee to clear the projects to be implemented with the World Bank assistance sanctioned in the G.O first read above.

3) The Director, Institute of Remote Sensing, Anna University, Chennai has sent an estimate for Rs.7.00 lakhs for conducting High Tide Line (HTL) demarcation for permanent houses for the selected survey numbers in the districts of Cuddalore, Tirunelveli, Kanyakumari, Villupuram, Thoothukudi, Nagapattinam and Kancheepuram based on the request of the Director of Environment .

4.The Officer on Special Duty (R&R) and Project Director (ETRP and TEAP) placed the same before the Empowered Committee meeting held on 02.03.2006. The Empowered Committee approved the same with the direction that the areas

demarcated by the Institute of Remote Sensing will be deleted from the area to be covered by the Consultants appointed by the Director of Environment separately.

5. The Government, after careful consideration accept the decision of the Empowered Committee and accordingly, sanction a sum of **Rs.7.00 lakhs (Rupees seven lakhs only)** for carrying out HTL demarcation for permanent houses for the selected survey numbers in Cuddalore, Tirunelveli, Kanyakumari, Villupuram, Thoothukudi, Nagapattinam and Kancheepuram Districts of Tamil Nadu with the World Bank assistance.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 5 above shall be debited to:

7. The District Collectors are requested to furnish the survey numbers and also the relevant village maps of the selected sites to the Director, Institute of Remote Sensing, Anna University, Chennai for the preparation of HTL Survey maps.

8. The Director of Environment, Chennai is authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in paragraph 5 above to the Director, Institute of Remote Sensing, Anna University, Chennai as per the existing procedure and send the Statement of Expenditure, Utilisation Certificate and the Progress Reports as laid down by World Bank in consultation with the Project Director. The Director of Environment is requested to ensure that the areas demarcated by the Institute of Remote Sensing are deleted from the areas to be covered by the consultants to be appointed by him separately.
