ORDER:

The Government, in G.O. Ms. Nos.681 & 682, Revenue (NC.II) Department, Dated 1.12.2008, have directed that the relief assistance of Rs.2000/- in cash be paid as a special case to those affected by the recent floods caused by Cyclone 'Nisha' in Chennai City and adjoining areas and Rs.1000/- in other affected districts in respect of those cases not covered under G.O. Ms. No.630, Revenue Department, Dated 29.10.2007.

2. The Government in G.O. Ms. No.695, Revenue (NC.II) Department, Dated 5.12.2008 and G.O.Ms.No.711, Revenue (NC.II) Department, Dated 12.12.2008 have sanctioned Rs. 400 crores for providing cash doles and relief package to the flood affected districts.

3. The District Collector, Chennai in her letter sixth read above, has requested to sanction an additional sum of Rs.10 Crores for providing relief assistance ordered in the G.O. first read above. In his letter seventh read above the Principal Secretary and Commissioner of Revenue Administration has also recommended the above request.

4. The Government accordingly sanction a sum of Rs.10 crores (Rupees Ten Crores only) to the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration for taking up disbursement of cash doles ordered in the G.O. first read above to the affected people in Chennai.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:

Cash Doles:

"2245 - Relief on account of Natural Calamities - 02 - Floods, Cyclones, etc., - 101 - Gratuitous Relief -I Non-Plan - AE - Cash Doles to persons affected in floods - 56 Feeding and Cash Doles" (DPC 2245 02 101 AE 5600)

6. Necessary additional funds will be provided in RE/FMA 2008-2009. This item of expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by specific inclusion in final supplementary estimates for 2008-2009. Pending provision of such funds in RE/FMA 2008-2009, the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is permitted to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned as per the existing procedure, to the District Collector, Chennai and send the utilization certificate to the Accountant General/ Government.

7. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is requested to include this item of expenditure while sending proposal for RE/FMA 2008-2009 without fail.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.234/FS/P/09, Dated 27.01.2009, and with ASL No.1620 (One Thousand Six Hundred and Twenty).
