ORDER:

The District Collector, Coimbatore district has informed that the heavy rains on 07.11.2009 and 08.11.2009 led to damages to Contour Canal and Aliyar Feeder Canal. He has forwarded the estimate furnished by the Public Works Department and requested sanction of funds to the tune of Rs.165.50 lakhs as follows for the restoration of damages:-

(Rs. in lakhs)

1.	Temporary restoration of flood damages in Contour Canal - 8 works	110.50
2.	Temporary restoration of flood damages in Aliyar Feeder Canal - 1 work	12.00
3.	Temporary restoration of flood damages in Vettaikkarapuram Canal - 1 work	10.00
4.	Temporary restoration of flood damages in Old Aliyar Channel - 4 works	18.00
5.	Temporary restoration of flood damages in Manakkadavu weir across Aliyar River	10.00
6.	Temporary restoration of flood damages in Sethumadai canal	5.00

The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has recommended that the request of the Collector, Coimbatore may be considered and funds may be sanctioned from Calamity Relief Fund.

2. The Government examined the proposal of Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and sanction a sum of Rs.1,20,00,000/- (Rupees One crore and twenty lakhs only) from the Calamity Relief Fund for temporary restoration of damages caused to Contour Canal and Aliyar Feeder Canal due to heavy rains during 07.11.2009 and 08.11.2009. The District Collector, Coimbatore is requested to restrict the expenditure to the amount sanctioned above.

3. The amount sanctioned in paragraph 2 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

2245 - Relief on account of Natural Calamities - 02 floods, cyclones etc - 122 Repairs and restoration of damaged irrigation and flood Control works - I Non-Plan AA - Repairs to irrigation sources (items eligible for Assistance from Union Government) - 16 Major works. (DPC 2245-02-122 AA 1608)

4. Necessary funds will be provided in RE/FMA 2009-2010. Pending provision of such funds in RE/FMA 2009-2010 the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is permitted to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in paragraph 2 above to the District Collector, Coimbatore as per the existing procedure and send the utilization certificate to the Accountant General / Government.

5. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is requested to include this item of expenditure while sending proposal of RE/FMA 2009-2010 to Finance Department without fail.
