ORDER:

In the letter first read above the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce requested permission to avail the Broadband connectivity service and to incur the expenditure of Rs.30,500 as one time payment to BSNL, Chennai and requested permission to incur the above amount.

2. In the letter second read above the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce reported that the existing dial-up internet connectivity provided in the Directorate is very slow in uploading of files from the Directorate and downloading of files through internet due to its low band width and that it is very difficult to surf the internet to download the data require for preparation of policies for promotion of industrial development in the State.

3. He has further stated that Broadband multi-user internet connectivity "Business Plan-3000" offered by BSNL, Chennai have been provided in the Directorate with a speed of 512 Kbps at a monthly rent of Rs.3000/- with download/upload limit of 10 GB per month. The additional usage charges beyond free download/upload limit of 10 GB is Rs.0.80 per MB and the monthly charges are being claimed in the regular phone bills to meet out the need for execution of the tasks.

4. Therefore, the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has requested that his action in having provided the Broadband multi-user internet connectivity under Business Plan 3000 offered by BSNL, Chennai, in anticipation of Government order may be ratified. He has also requested to sanction a sum of Rs.30,500/- as one time payment to BSNL, Chennai.

5. The Government have examined the proposal of the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce in detail and direct that his action in having provided the Broadband Multi-user internet connectivity under Business Plan 3000 offered by BSNL, Chennai in anticipation of Government orders is ratified. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is also directed to discontinue the above Broadband connectivity after the functioning of TNSWAN which is likely to function in near future and to approach TNSWAN in this regard. They also accord sanction for a sum of Rs.30,500/- (Rupees Thirty thousand and five hundred only) as one time payment to BSNL, Chennai. Subject to the condition that the proposed expenditure shall be accommodated with in the Budget Provision 2006-07.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following Head of account.
