ORDER:

The Government, after careful consideration, release a sum of Rs.43,83,480/- (Rupees Forty Three Lakhs Eighty Three Thousand Four Hundred and Eighty only) towards the cost of training for sanctioned cases for the III and IV Quarters of 2006-07 under the Prime Minister's Rozgar Yojana Scheme in 2006-07.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited under the following head of account:-

“2851.00 – Village and Small Industries – 800 – Other expenditure – schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan – III – Centrally Sponsored – SA Schemes for implementation of PMRY – 72. Training”. (D.P. Code No.2851-00-800-SA-7202).

5. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is authorized to draw and disburse the amount to the beneficiaries / training institutions.

6. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is instructed to ensure complete utilization of the amount by obtaining utilization certificate from the beneficiaries / training institutions and send quarterly reports on the amount spent to Government of India direct with a copy marked to State Government.
