**ORDER:**

In the Government Order first read above, Prime Minister's Rozgar Yojana for the educated unemployed youth was launched with effect from 2<sup>nd</sup> October 1993 with a view to provide sustained self employment to about 10 lakhs educated unemployed youth in micro enterprises.

2. In the letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Government of India have released Rs.20,67,750/- (Rupees Twenty Lakhs Sixty Seven Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty only) towards second release of contingency funds to Tamil Nadu under Prime Minister's Rozgar Yojana for the cases sanctioned during 2006-07. The amount has been credited into the account of the State Government. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has requested to release the said amount.

3. The Government, after careful consideration, have decided to accept the proposal of the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce. Accordingly, sanction is accorded to incur a sum of not exceeding Rs.20,67,750/- (Rupees Twenty Lakhs Sixty Seven Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty only) towards the expenditure on contingencies of the sanctioned cases under the Prime Minister's Rozgar Yojana during 2006-07.

4. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above to the General Managers, District Industries Centres and Regional Joint Director of Industries and Commerce, Chennai. The funds should be utilized for the purposes stipulated in the Government of India letter second read above.

5. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is also instructed to obtain utilization certificate and send it to the Government of India under intimation to Government.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited under the following head of account:-

“2851.00 – village and Small Industries – 800 – Other expenditure – schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan – III – Centrally Sponsored – SA Schemes for the implementation of PMRY – 72. Training”. (D.P. Code No.2851-00-800-SA-7202).
