



ABSTRACT

Small Industries - Prime Minister's Rozgar Yojana – Sanction of first release of Training Fund of Rs.45.00 lakhs for the year 2007-08 – Orders issued.

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ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, Prime Minister's Rozgar Yojana for the educated unemployed youth was launched with effect from 2nd October 1993 with a view to provide sustained self employment to about 10 lakhs educated unemployed youth in micro enterprises.

2. The Government of India have fixed a target of 28,700 to be trained under Prime Minister's Rozgar Yojana in Tamil Nadu during 2007-08. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce in his letter second read above has sent proposals to the Government of India for release of funds towards PMRY Training and Contingency Fund for the year 2007-08 to the tune of Rs.574.00 lakhs.

3. In the meanwhile, in the Standing Committee Meeting on Centrally Sponsored Schemes / Shared Schemes in respect of Small Industries Department held on 2.5.07, the committee has authorized to sanction a sum of Rs.45.00 lakhs for Prime Minister's Rozgar Yojana pending release of funds from the Government of India.

4. The Government have decided to sanction Rs.45.00 lakhs towards first release of Prime Minister's Rozgar Yojana Training Fund for the year 2007-08, pending release of funds from the Government of India. Accordingly sanction is accorded for release of a sum of Rs.45.00 lakhs (Rupees Forty Five lakhs only) towards the cost of training for sanctioned cases under the Prime Minister's Rozgar Yojana for the year 2007-08.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited under the following head of account:

“2851.00 – Village and Small Industries – 800 – Other expenditure – Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan – III – Centrally Sponsored – SA Schemes for implementation of Prime Minister’s Rozgar Yojana – 72. Training”. (D.P. Code No.2851-00-800-SA-7202).

6. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is authorized to draw and disburse the amount to the beneficiaries / training institutions.

7. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is instructed to ensure complete utilization of the amount by obtaining utilization certificate from the beneficiaries / training institutions and send quarterly reports on the amount spent to Government of India with a copy marked to this Government.
