Small Industries – Setting up of Common Modern Tool Room by Coimbatore Industrial Infrastructure Association under Industrial Infrastructure Upgradation Scheme – Sanction of State Government's share of Rs.1.21 crores – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Government forwarded the detailed project report of the Coimbatore District Small Scale Industries Association (CODISSIA) for Pump, Motor, Foundry and Allied Industries, Coimbatore for financial assistance under Industrial Infrastructure Upgradation Scheme to the Government of India for approval and release of grant. While the project report was under the consideration of the Government of India, another project report for Pump, Motor and Foundry Cluster was submitted by the Coimbatore Industrial Infrastructure Association (COINDIA) directly to the Government of India which was approved by the Government of India.

2. Initially, the Government of India, in the letter second read above approved the project at a total outlay of Rs.63.50 crores of which the grant from Government of India under Industrial Infrastructure Upgradation Scheme would be Rs.30.44 crores. The balance have to be met by the stake holders and by borrowings from lending agencies / State Government. Later the Government of India has revised the project cost as Rs.56.90 crores out of

which Rs.39.59 crores would be the contribution of Government of India as grant under Industrial Infrastructure Upgradation Scheme.

3. One of the components in the project is setting up of "Common Modern Tool Room". During December 2006 the Government of India agreed to this component at a project cost of Rs.13.50 crores and the grant of the Government of India under Industrial Infrastructure Upgradation Scheme would be Rs.10.00 crores.

4. During 2003 itself, the State Government has committed to provide Rs.1.21 crores towards setting up of Modern Tool Room Centre under Part II Schemes for 2003-04 to be set up by Coimbatore District Small Scale Industries Association and it was decided to release the amount to the Coimbatore District Small Scale Industries Association after getting the approval of the Government of India for the project.

5. The President, Coimbatore Industrial Infrastructure Association, in his letter third read above has requested the Government to sanction Rs.1.21 crores to Coimbatore Industrial Infrastructure Association, which is implementing the Pump, Motor and Foundry Cluster under Industrial Infrastructure Upgradation Scheme. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce in his letter fifth read above has recommended the above request of Coimbatore Industrial Infrastructure Association.

6. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the request of Coimbatore Industrial Infrastructure Association in para 5 above. Accordingly the Government sanction a sum of Rs.1.21 crores (Rupees One Crore and Twenty One Lakhs only) to Coimbatore Industrial Infrastructure Association as State Government's contribution for setting up of "Common Modern Tool Room" in Coimbatore being one of the components in the Pump, Motor and Foundry Cluster.

7. The expenditure is on a "NEW SERVICE" and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be met by an advance from Contingency Fund. Orders regarding this will be issued by Finance (BG-I) Department separately. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is requested to apply to the Finance (BG-I) Department in the prescribed Proforma for the sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce may be requested to include this expenditure while sending the proposal for First Supplementary Estimate for 2007-08.

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited under the following head of account.

9. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is the Estimating, Reconciling and Controlling Authority of the above New Head of Account.

10. The Pay and Accounts Officer / Treasury Officer concerned are requested to open the above New Head of Account on their accounts.

11. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 6 above to the Coimbatore Industrial Infrastructure Association, Coimbatore.

12. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its UO No. 60066/Ind/07 dated 19.9.2007 and ASL No. 959 (Nine Hundred and Fifty Nine).
