ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Government of India have conveyed the sanction of the President to the payment of non-recurring grant of Rs.459.45 lakh (Rupees four hundred fifty nine lakh and forty five thousand only) to this Government for provisioning / replacement of cooking equipments / devices in 9189 schools @ Rs.5,000/- per school in the State under the National Programme of Nutritional Support to Primary Education (MDM Scheme), 2006 as stipulated in para 2.3 (vi) of the Guidelines of NPNSPE, 2006.

2. The above grant was released to this Government during the last week of March, 2007. The amount could not be utilized during the financial year 2006-07 and the Government of India was requested to carry forward the grant for 2007-08. The Government of India has granted permission to carry forward the grant to the tune of Rs.459.45 lakh (Rupees four hundred fifty nine lakh and forty five thousand only) available with the State Government as on 31-3-2007 for utilization during 2007-08 out of central assistance sanctioned during 2006-07 for

provisioning / replacement of cooking equipments / kitchen devices as per the norms / guidelines and should not be utilized / diverted for any other purpose.

3. The Director of Social Welfare was requested to send a suitable proposal incorporating the coverage of list of districts and allotment break up details. Accordingly, the Director of Social Welfare has sent list of districts and allotment of funds details for provisioning / replacement of cooking equipments / kitchen devices during 2007-08 in 9189 schools @ Rs.5,000/- per school in the State under the National Programme of Nutritional Support to Primary Education (MDM Scheme), 2006 as stipulated in para 2.3 (vi) of the Guidelines of NPNSPE, 2006.

4. After careful consideration of the proposal of the Director of Social Welfare, based on the permission granted by Government of India, the Government accord sanction of Rs.459.45 lakhs (Rupees four hundred and fifty nine lakh and forty five thousand only) to incur an expenditure towards provisioning / replacement of cooking equipments / devices in 9189 schools @ Rs.5,000/- per school in the State under the National Programme of Nutritional Support to Primary Education (MDM Scheme), 2006 as stipulated in para 2.3 (vi) of the Guidelines of NPNSPE, 2006. The programme shall be implemented in the following districts with the allocation of funds as indicated against each other.

The above District Collectors are permitted to purchase cooking equipments / cooking devices (stove) containers for storage of food grains and other ingredients on the basis of the actual requirements of the school.

5. The expenditure sanctioned above shall be debitable to the following head of account:-

“ 2236 – Nutrition-02 – Distribution of nutritious food and beverages – 102 Mid Day Meals schemes under Eleventh Five Year Plan – III Centrally Sponsored – SA – National Programme of Nutritional Support to Primary Education (Mid Day Meals Scheme) – 24 Materials and Supplies “ (DPC 2236 02 102 SA 2406)

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para-4 above will be provided in RE/FMA - 2007 -08. Pending provision of such fund, the Director of Social Welfare is authorized to incur the expenditure. The Director of Social Welfare is requested to send the proposal at the appropriate time so as to include this amount in RE /FMA – 2007-08.

7. The Director of Social Welfare will be the estimating, reconciling and controlling authority of the above head of account.

8. The Director of Social Welfare is permitted to implement the scheme of provision / replacement of kitchen devices following the guidelines of NPNSPE (MDM Scheme), 2006 as stipulated in para 2.3 (vi). The Director of Social Welfare is instructed to redistribute the amount sanctioned in para-4 above among the districts based on the actual requirement. As far as possible procurement of cooking equipments / devices shall be done in a decentralized manner, preferably at school / block level so that there is no delay in making available the required equipments / devices to the schools as instructed by Government of India.

9. The Director of Social Welfare and District Collectors shall maintain a separate and proper account of the money received. A register of Assets acquired out of this release shall be maintained as per rules in force. The amount sanctioned in para-4 above shall be utilized before 31st March 2008. The Director of Social Welfare shall furnish the utilization certificate to Government indicating the number of schools districtwise where kitchen equipments / devices have been provided through grant as well as progress reports for the quarters ending 31st December, 2007 and 31st March 2008.

10. The Director of Social Welfare is requested to issue necessary instructions to Personal Assistants (NMP) to District Collectors to implement the scheme, without any deviation and

- a. Ensure better monitoring and implementation of the scheme ;
- b. Ensure that the kitchen devices / utensils are uniform in type and design, according to the strength ;

11. The District Collectors are instructed to provide infrastructural elements to the nutritious meal centres by convergence with other development programmes as stipulated in para 2.3 (vi) of the Guidelines of NPNSPE, 2006.
