ORDER:

In the reference first read above, the Government of India have conveyed the sanction of the President of India to the release of Rs.2282.40 lakh (Rupees two thousand two hundred eighty two lakhs and forty thousands only) for construction of kitchen cum store at primary and upper primary stage under NPMDMS (MDM scheme) for 2008-09, at the rate of Rs.60,000/- per school / per centre as detailed below:-

Based on the central assistance received, the Commissioner of Social Welfare was requested to send necessary proposal to utilise the funds sanctioned by the Government of India for construction of 3804 kitchen cum store at primary and upper primary stage under NPMDMS (MDM scheme) for 2008-09 at the rate of Rs.60,000/- per school / per centre.

3. Accordingly, the Commissioner of Social Welfare has sent the proposals for construction of kitchen cum stores in the order of preference ie. Corporations, municipalities, district, taluk headquarters, town panchayats and also noon meal centres with higher number of beneficiaries.

4. After careful consideration of the proposal of Commissioner of Social Welfare, the Government accord sanction to incur the expenditure to the tune of Rs.2282.40 lakh (Rupees two thousand two hundred and eighty two lakhs and forty thousands only) by the Commissioner of Social Welfare, towards construction of 3804 kitchen cum stores at the rate of Rs.60,000/- per centre / per school, for both primary and upper primary school of education under NPMDMS, for 2008-09, as detailed below:-

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para- 4 above shall be debitible under the following head of account :-

“ 4236 – Capital outlay on Nutrition 02 – Distribution of Nutritious Food and Beverages – 800 Other Expenditure – Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan – III – Centrally Sponsored Scheme – SC – National Programme of Nutritional Support to Primary Education (Mid Day Meal Scheme) - Construction of kitchen – cum – store – 16 Major works (DPC No.4236 02 800 SC 1605) ”

6. Necessary funds have been provided in RE 2008-09 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in para-4 above.

7. The Commissioner of Social Welfare is permitted to implement the scheme and he is authorized to redistribute the amount sanctioned in para-4 above among the districts for construction of kitchen cum stores at the Government and Local Body schools under National Programme of Mid Day Meals in Schools, as per the NPNSPE Guidelines, 2006.

8. The Commissioner of Social Welfare / District Collectors are also instructed to adopt design of the kitchen-cum-store as suggested in Annexure – IX (read with para 4.2 of NPNSPE Guidelines, 2006) as far as possible.

9. The Commissioner of Social Welfare / District Collectors shall maintain a register of immovable properties and other such records as prescribed in the Rules, and they are instructed to utilize the amount sanctioned in para-4 above in full and furnish the utilization certificate to Government early for onward transmission to Government of India.

10. The District Collectors concerned are instructed to provide infrastructural elements to the nutritious meal centres by convergence with other development programmes as envisaged in para 2.5 of the NPNSPE Guidelines, 2006.

11. The Commissioner of Social Welfare is requested to issue necessary instructions to District Collectors to implement the scheme, without any deviation and

- a. Ensure better monitoring and implementation of the scheme ;
- b. Ensure that the construction of kitchen cum stores are being constructed according to the design and conditions mentioned in NPNSPE, 2006 and more particularly the conditions contained in para 4.2 of the NPNSPE, 2006;
