### **ORDER :**

The Government of India, in their letter dated 18.11.2008, among others, have approved providing Uniform(i.e., two Sarees at the rate of Rs.200/- per Saree / per annum) and a name tag (i.e., Badge at the rate of Rs.25/- per badge/per annum) to each Anganwadi Worker and Anganwadi Helpers under Integrated Child Development Services Scheme, with sharing pattern of 90:10 between Government of India and State Government for the year 2009-10. The Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has sent proposal to Government to provide Uniform and Badges to all 50433 Anganwadi Worker and 47265 Anganwadi Helpers at a total cost of Rs.4,15,21,650/- (Government of India 90% Share - Rs.3,73,69,485 and State Government 10% Share - Rs.41,52,165/-).

2) The Principal Secretary / Commissioner, ICDS has stated that it has been decided to give Blue Colour saree with Golden Border to Anganwadi Workers and Honey Colour with Orange Border to Anganwadi Helpers with ICDS emblem printed on the Border and the sarees will be procured from Co-optex, Chennai. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner, ICDS has further stated that only one name tag i.e., badge has been approved by Government of India and in respect of issue of badges to Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers, the Child Development Project Officers concerned may be entrusted with this work and they may be authorized to incur the expenditure.

3) The revised guidelines issued by the Government of India envisages the cost sharing ratio between Centre and States to be effective from 2009-2010 as under;

- i) 90:10 for all components including SNP for North East;
- ii) 50:50 for SNP and 90:10 for all other components for all States other than North East.

4) The Principal Secretary/Commissioner, ICDS has proposed to purchase Uniform to Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers through Co-optex, Chennai with the colour and specifications mentioned at para 2 above and requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.4,15,21,650/- (GOI 90% Share -Rs.3,73,69,485/- and State Government 10% Share - Rs.41,52,165/-) for procurement of Sarees and Badges

5) In the meantime, the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, on the occasion of the Conference convened by Noon Meal and Anganwadi Workers on 21.11.2009, made an announcement that the Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers working in Child Centres (Anganwadi Centres) under ICDS scheme will be provided two sarees per annum as uniform and totally 97,698 employees will be benefitted by the provision of Uniform.

6) In the circumstances stated above, the Government have examined the proposal of the Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme, and, consequent on the above announcement of Hon'ble Chief Minister, accord sanction for a sum of Rs.4,15,21,650/- (Rupees Four Crore Fifteen Lakhs Twenty One Thousand Six Hundred and Fifty Only) for providing two sarees @ Rs.200/- each as Uniform to all Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers at a Cost of Rs.3,90,79,200/- and Rs.24,42,450/- for providing name tag (Badge) @ Rs.25/- to all Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers. Out of the above expenditure 90% share i.e., Rs.3,73,69,485/- shall be reimbursed from the Government of India and the balance 10% i.e., Rs.41,52,165/- shall be borne by the State Government.

7) The amount sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited under the following Head of Account:-

8) The amount sanctioned in para 6 above is a "NEW SERVICE" and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by an advance from the Contingency Fund of the State, orders regarding which will be issued by Finance (BG.I) Department. The Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner, ICDS is requested to send necessary proposals to the Government in Finance (BG.I) Department for sanction of advance from the Contingency Fund in the prescribed form with a copy of this order.

9) This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.19/JS (APA) / 10-1, dated.21.01.2010 and ASL No.1474 (One Thousand Four Hundred and Seventy Four).


