NPMDMS - Release of central assistance of Rs.426.30 lakh for procurement of kitchen devices in 8526 schools for 2008-09 – Orders issued

ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Government of India have conveyed the sanction of the President of India to the release of Rs.426.30 lakhs (Rupees four hundred twenty six lakh and thirty thousand only) for procurement of kitchen devices at primary and upper primary stage under National Programme of Mid Day Meals in Schools (MDM scheme) for 2008-09, at the rate of Rs.5,000/- per school / centre as detailed below:-

Accordingly, the Commissioner of Social Welfare has sent the proposal for provision / replacement of cooking equipments / kitchen devices in 8526 schools under NPMDMS (MDM Scheme) at the rate of Rs.5000/- per school / per centre at a total cost of Rs.426.30 lakh indicating the name of districts, allotment of funds and no. of nutritious meal centres for which cooking equipment / kitchen devices have to be provided / replaced for the financial year 2008-09 separately for primary and upper primary stage.

3. After careful consideration of the proposal of the Commissioner of Social Welfare, the Government accord sanction to incur the expenditure to the tune of Rs. 426.30 lakhs (Rupees four hundred and twenty six lakh and thirty thousand only) by the Commissioner of Social Welfare, towards procurement of cooking devices in 8526 schools @ Rs.5,000/- per school in the State under the NPMDMS, as detailed below :-

4. The expenditure sanctioned above shall be debitible to the following head of account:-

“ 2236 – Nutrition-02 – Distribution of nutritious food and beverages – 102 Mid Day Meals Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan – III Centrally Sponsored schemes – SA – National Programme of Nutritional Support to Primary Education (Mid Day Meal Scheme) – 24 Materials and Supplies ” (DPC 2236 02 102 SA 2406)

5. Necessary funds have been provided in RE 2008-09 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in para-3 above.

6. The Commissioner of Social Welfare is requested to implement the programme in the districts with the allocation of funds following the guidelines of NPNSPE, 2006 as stipulated in para 2.3 (vi). The District Collectors concerned, are permitted to purchase cooking equipments / cooking devices (stove) containers for storage of food grains and other ingredients and utensils for cooking and serving on the basis of the actual requirements of the school. As far as possible procurement of cooking equipments & kitchen devices shall be done in a decentralized manner preferably at school / block level, so that there is no delay in making available the required devices to the schools as instructed by the Government of India.

7. The Commissioner of Social Welfare and District Collectors shall maintain a separate and proper account of the money received. A register of Assets acquired out of this release shall be maintained as per rules in force. The amount sanctioned in para-3 above shall be utilized before 31st March 2008. The Commissioner of Social Welfare shall furnish the utilization certificate to Government indicating the number of schools districtwise where kitchen equipments / devices have been provided through the central assistance received in this order and as well as quarterly progress reports periodically.

8. The Commissioner of Social Welfare is requested to issue necessary instructions to Personal Assistants (NMP) to District Collectors to implement the scheme, without any deviation and

- a. Ensure better monitoring and implementation of the scheme ;
- b. Ensure that the kitchen devices / utensils are uniform in type and design, according to the strength ;
