ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above, orders have been issued appointing 23 District Central Co-operative Banks in Tamil Nadu as Channalising Agencies for receiving funds from the National Handicapped Finance and Development Corporation as per the existing conditions of the National Handicapped Finance and Development Corporation and in the G.O. second read above, orders have been issued, among other things, appointing, the Tamil Nadu State Apex Co-operative Bank as Nodal Agency for receiving funds from the National Handicapped Finance and Development Corporation and the Tamil Nadu State Apex Co-operative Bank in turn will refinance to the District Central Co-operative Banks in order to implement the scheme successfully in the State as per the existing conditions of the National Handicapped Finance and Development Corporation.

2. The State Commissioner for the Disabled has stated that the Registrar of Co-operative Societies has reported that there are more than 100 urban Co-operative Banks in the state which will enhance the coverage of the National Handicapped Finance Development Corporation scheme and will facilitate better implementation of the scheme. The State Commissioner for the Disabled has, therefore, requested the Government to include urban Co-operative banks as

additional channelising agencies in the implementation of National Handicapped Finance and Development Corporation schemes so as to achieve the target of Rs.4.00 crores. (Rupees Four Crores only)

3. After careful consideration, the Government, accept the proposal of the State Commissioner for the Disabled. Accordingly, the Government appoint the Urban Co-operative Banks as additional channelising agencies for selection and forwarding of applications of disabled persons under National Handicapped Finance Development Corporation Schemes for Disabled.

4. This order issues with the concurrence of the Co-operation, Food and Consumer Protection Department and Finance departments vide their U.O.Nos 6354/CP2/2008-12, dated 20.3.2008 and 18407/SW/2008, dated 10.4.2008 respectively
