ORDER:

The Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu in his letter first read above has stated that a 400 m synthetic athletic track has been laid recently in the Race Course Stadium at Madurai at a cost of Rs.250.00 lakhs and the stadium complex also comprises of a grass football ground, 2 Synthetic Tennis courts, 2 Basketball courts, Volleyball, Kabaddi, Cricket playfields and a Hall for Badminton. He has stated that a sports hostel is also located in this complex and 120 players from Tamil Nadu is staying in this sports complex and getting trained and are studying in the nearby schools. Apart from this, Sprint & Jumps Academy, being organized by Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu is conducting coaching camp for 80 boys and girls every month. For floodlight facility, floodlight towers are already available in the 4 corners of the 400 m athletic track. The Member Secretary has stated that in order to conduct State level and National level competitions in the late night hours and for training the Sports Hostel boys and girls, floodlight towers need to be renovated and new floodlight facility has to be provided in the stadium at a cost of Rs.50.00 lakhs.

2. The Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu has therefore requested the Government to provide necessary funds to the tune of Rs.50 lakhs (non-recurring) under the Part-II Schemes 2007-2008, for the renovation of the existing floodlight facilities at the Race Course Stadium at Madurai.

3. The Government after careful consideration, accept the request of the Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu and accord sanction for an expenditure of Rs.50 lakhs (Rupees Fifty Lakhs only) as non-recurring Expenditure for the renovation of the existing floodlighting facilities at the Race Course Stadium in Madurai, under the Part-II Schemes for the year 2007-2008.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:

“2204 - 00 Sports and Youth Services – 104 Sports and Games – Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan – II State Plan – JW Grants to Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu for Establishment of Sports

Complex – 09 Grants-in-Aid – 03 Grants for specific schemes” (DPC 2204 00 104 JW 0936)

5. The Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu shall prepare the bill for the amount sanctioned in paragraph 3 above and present it at the Pay and Accounts Office, Secretariat, Chennai-9 through the Under Secretary to Government, Youth Welfare and Sports Development Department, Chennai. The above sanctioned amount shall not be paid in cash but shall be credited into the following head of account:

"K.Deposits and Advances (B) Deposits not bearing interest – 8443 00 Civil Deposits – 800 Other deposits – CH – Deposits of Tamil Nadu Sports Development Authority (DPC 8443 00 800 CH 000D)" by means of cheque / demand draft drawn in favour of **PD Account No.6184513932**".

6. The Member Secretary, Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu shall send the detailed expenditure report, utilization certificate, completion certificate etc., to Government in due course.
