Sub: Model Guidelines for grant of permission by States\Union Territories (UT) for movement of Over weight \ Over Dimensional Consignments\ (OWCs/ODCs) by Modular Hydraulic Trailers-appointment of Nodal officer orders-Issued-Regading.

ORDER:

The Central Government have formulated the Overall Dimensions of Motor vehicles (Prescription of Conditions for exemption) Rules 1991, and empowered the state governments to exempt any motor vehicle from the provision of Rule 93(over all dimensions) of the Central Motor Vehicle. Rules 1989.

Based on the above, now permission is being granted by the State Government to the transporters and infrastructure companies to carry their over dimensional consignments by Modular hydraulic trailers.

In the reference 2nd cited, the Government of India, New Delhi, have stated that in order to avoid difficulties encountered by the transporters and infrastructure companies like BHEL, NTPC etc in transportation of OWCs/ODCs like turbines, stators etc by Modular Hydraulic Trailers, the Ministry has been taking various measures to streamline the procedure for grant of permission by the concerned State and Central authorities, even then the transporters continue to report their difficulties in movement of their consignment.

Hence, the Ministry has given a Model Guidelines (Enclosed in the Annexure) for grant of Permission by states \ Union Territories (UT) for movement of Over Weight \ Over Dimensional consignments (OWCs/ODCs) by modular Hydraulic Trailers.

In order to speed up the process of getting exemption order from the Government as applied by the transporters for movement of their consignment, the Assistant Secretary-2 is appointed as Nodal Officer.

He will ensure the procedures stipulated are followed and coordinate with other departments and the Government, till exemption order is granted to the applicant.
