

## RECRUITMENT OF Gr. II PCs (M&W) 2006

### 1. NOTIFICATION

A notification in Rc.No.A1/3434/2006 has been published in Tamil dailies on 22.11.2006 inviting applications for the post of Gr. II PCs (Men& Women) 2006. The last date for submission of applications with a fee of Rs.150/- in the form of Demand Draft is 21.12. 2006.

### 2. VACANCIES

In this recruitment 4543 vacancies of Gr.II PCs(3164 men and 1379 Women) are to be filled up.

### 3. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION

The applicant should have passed the SSLC of old pattern or Xth of the new pattern. They should possess sound knowledge in Tamil. Candidates taken Tamil medium of instruction or studied Tamil language as one of the subject are considered to possess adequate knowledge in Tamil. If they did not possess sound knowledge in Tamil they should pass second-class language test in Tamil conducted by the Tamilnadu Public Service Commission within a period of three years from the date of appointment.

### 4. AGE

Age norms fixed for the OC, BC, MBC candidates are that they should have completed 18 years of age and should not have completed 24 years of age as on 1.7.2006. SC/ST candidates should have completed 18 years of age and should not have completed 29 years of age as on 1.7.06. The maximum age limit for the destitute widows is 35 years as on 1.7.06. The ex-servicemen should have completed 18 years of age and should not have completed 45 years of age as on 1.7.06. on the date of notification i.e.22.11.06 three years should not have elapsed from the date of their discharge from the Armed Forces. The ex-servicemen who served in Armed Forces in the grade of Driver, Auto mechanic, Auto Electrician and Armourer would be given exemption from attending the P.E.T. and they will be straight away allowed to sit for the Written Examination after scrutiny of the original certificates.

### 5. PHYSICAL MEASUREMENTS

### 6. RESERVATION OF VACANCIES FOR WARDS/DEPENDENTS

10% reservation of the total vacancies would be given to the wards/dependents of the serving, retired, medically invalidated, deceased police personnel. Out of the 10% reservation, 10% would be given to the wards of the Ministerial Staff working in Police Department.

## **7. SCRUTINY OF CERTIFICATES**

After scrutiny of records at the time of Certificate Verification, the candidates will be subjected to undergo Physical Endurance Test/Physical Efficiency Test.

## **8. PHYSICAL ENDURANCE TEST**

For male candidates 1500 metres Running in 7 minutes and for female candidates 400 metres in 2 minutes. Only candidates succeeded in Physical Endurance Test would be allowed to attend Physical Efficiency Test.

## **9. PHYSICAL EFFICIENCY TEST**

Each candidate has to choose three events among five events. Each event is a qualifying stage for further process. Failure in one event will entail disqualification.

**(A) MALE:** Rope Climbing is a compulsory event for the male candidates. Only one chance will be given for Rope Climbing. Men can choose one of the jump events of Long Jump or High Jump and one of the running event of 100 mtrs or 400 mtrs as their choice. Two chances will be given for Jump events and only one chance for Running Events. The male candidates should secure a minimum of 3 stars or 6 marks out of 6 stars/15 marks in the P.E.T. to allow them for the written test.

**(B) FEMALE:** Long Jump is a compulsory event for female candidates. Women can choose one of the events of Cricket Ball throw or Shotput and one of the Running event either 100 mtrs or 200 mtrs as per their choice. Candidates would be given two chances in Long Jump and only one chance in Cricket Ball Throw or Shot-put. Mere participation in the PET by female candidates is allowed and they will be permitted to write the written test.

## **10. WRITTEN TEST**

The written test is of objective type for a total marks of 80 comprising two sections i.e. General Knowledge for 50 marks and Psychology for 30 marks. They should secure a minimum of 40 marks in the written test.

## **11. EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

The candidates are also awarded marks for their participation in the NCC/NSS/Sports/Games upto 5 marks.

## **12. PROVISIONAL SELECT LIST**

Provisional select list is drawn based on the marks secured by the candidates in PET/Written Test/Special Qualification by applying communal rotation and the same will be sent to DGP/TN, Chennai 4 for causing Medical Examination and Police Verification and for issuance of appointment orders to them after clearance in Medical Examination and Police Verification.
