ORDER:-

In the G.O. first read above, the Government have accorded Administrative Sanction for the work of "Upgradation, Repair and Renovation of Government Hospital at Myladuthurai in Nagapattinam District for Rs.100 lakh under Emergency Tsunami Reconstruction Project (ETRP) assisted by World Bank.

2. The District Collector, Nagapattinam in his letter 13.9.2008 has stated that the level of the above newly constructed hospital building is lower than the other buildings around the hospital and adjoining school premises ground level. He further stated that during the rainy season, water stagnates around the hospital building causing hygienic problems. Based on the estimate prepared by Executive Engineer Building (C&M) Division, Nagapattinam for Rs.11.50 lakh for "Filling the low lying area with conveyed earth and sand gravel mix around the Government Hospital Building at Myladuthurai in Nagapattinam District,

Chief Engineer (Buildings) has sent a proposal for sanction of Rs.11.50 lakh for the above work.

3. The Officer on Special Duty (Relief and Rehabilitation) has placed the above proposal before the Empowered Committee meeting held on 23.3.2009. The Empowered Committee has approved the proposal.

4. The Government after careful consideration, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department as approved by the Empowered Committee and accord sanction for a sum of **Rs.11,50,000/- (Rupees Eleven lakh and fifty thousand only)** towards the cost for "Filling the low lying area with conveyed earth and sand gravel mix around the Government Hospital Building at Myladuthurai in Nagapattinam District under Emergency Tsunami Reconstruction Project (ETRP).

5. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"4210. Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health - 01. Urban Health Services - 110. Hospital and Dispensaries (Including Pharmacy) - II. State Plan - QA. Works under Emergency Tsunami Reconstruction Project (ETRP) with assistance from World Bank - Public Works Department (Buildings)-16. Major Works." (DPC 4210-01-110-QA-1605)

6. Necessary funds will be provided in RE/FMA 2009-2010. Pending provision of funds, the Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department is authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in paragraph 4 above as per the existing procedure and to send the statement of Expenditure, Utilization Certificate and the Progress Report as laid down by World Bank in consultation with the Project Director (ETRP / TEAP) to Government/ Accountant General.
