Tsunami - Tsunami Rehabilitation Programme - Coir Sector - Setting up of yarn spinning unit in Tsunami affected coastal areas - Sanction of funds from Government of India - Approved by Empowered Committee - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:-

The Planning Commission, Government of India, approved an allocation of Rs.45/- lakhs (Rupees Forty five lakhs only) under "Social infrastructure and welfare" sector mainly for industries in the tsunami affected areas of coastal districts to regenerate the coir trade and rehabilitate the workers.

2. The Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has stated that the following 5 coir Industrial Co-operative Societies functioning in the coastal districts have been selected to set up an Automatic Yarn Spinning unit at a cost of Rs.9.00 lakh each:-

- a) Dr. Ambedkar Coir Rope & Coir mat and Matting Workers' Industrial Co-operative Society, Cuddalore District.
- b) Thanthai Periyar Coir workers' Industrial Cooperative Society, Marakanam, Villupuram District.

- c) Kottur Adidravidar Coir & Coir Projects Industrial Cooperative Society, Adhichapuram, Tiruvarur District.
- d) Peravurani Coconut Fibre & Coir Products Industrial Cooperative Society Ltd., Seruvaviduthi, Thanjavur District.
- e) Kanyakumari District Industrial Cooperative Rubber Factory (Under Liquidation), Verkilambi, Kanyakumari District.

The cost of the machinery and equipments to be purchased for each unit is noted below:-

He has requested to sanction of Rs.45/- lakhs to set up an Automatic Yarn Spinning Unit in the tsunami affected areas in 5 coastal districts under Tsunami Rehabilitation Programme already approved by the Government of India.

3. The Officer on Special Duty (Relief and Rehabilitation) has placed the above proposal before the Empowered Committee meeting held on 15.7.2008. The Empowered Committee has approved the proposal.

4. Regarding sanction of assistance to Kanyakumari District Cooperative Rubber Factory at Verkilambi which is under liquidation, the Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has informed that the above society owns land and building and that the scheme assistance would enable the society to revive production and provide rehabilitation to the coir workers in the region. He has also informed that he is empowered to revive the factory under section 142 of TNCS Act 1983.

5. The Government after careful consideration accept the proposal of the Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce as recommended by the Empowered Committee and accord sanction for a sum of **Rs.45,00,000/- (Rupees Forty five lakhs only)** towards the setting up of an Automatic Spinning Unit in the tsunami affected areas in 5 coastal districts as mentioned in paragraph 2 above under

Tsunami Rehabilitation Programme funded by Union Planning Commission of Government of India.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

**"2245. Relief on account of Natural Calamities-80. General-800. Other expenditure-I. Non Plan-AB. Assistance for undertaking relief works in tsunami affected areas-09. Grants-in-aid-01. Grants for current expenditure."

7. The Special Commissioner and Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in paragraph 5 above.
