



Abstract

Tsunami - Emergency Tsunami Reconstruction Project (ETRP) assisted by World Bank - Vulnerability Reduction of Coastal Communities (VRCC) reconstruction of Vulnerable houses - Selection of beneficiaries by Tsunami Revenue Wing for Phase-II housing programme - Sanction of funds to meet out the expenses by the survey team for hiring of vehicles at Rs.1000/- per day for Rs.1.00 lakhs per District - Orders- Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have permitted to form Survey Teams to enumerate the Vulnerable houses as defined in the para 5(ii) of Government Order, which are located between 0-1000 metres from HTL, 0-200 metres from Backwater and all the IAY and other Financial houses that are located between 0-1000 metres from HTL and which are more than 10 years old as on 1.1.2006. A sum of Rs.30.12 crore, was also sanctioned which include Rs.30.00 crore towards the acquisition of lands and Rs.12.00 lakhs towards hiring vehicles at the rate of Rs.1000/- per day per team for the use of Survey Teams and other contingencies and also prescribed a format for the purpose of conduct of survey.

2. In the Government Order second read above, the Government formulated a new Housing Policy of Phase-II housing programme and also entitlement Matrix for the rural and urban areas.

3. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that the entire survey has to be redone in the district of Tiruvallur, Kancheepuram. Villupuram. Cuddalore, Nagapattinam. Pudukottai, Thanjavur, Thoothukudi, Tirunelveli, Ramanathapuram and Kanniyakumari in order to incorporate the suggestion made by the World Bank and also the guideline framed in the Housing Policy and Entitlement Matrix. In essence, the survey work should be complementary and supplementary to the suggestions made by World Bank and Government of Tamil Nadu. He has, therefore, requested to sanction a sum of Rs.11.00 lakhs of (Rupees Eleven Lakh only) at the rate of Rs.1.00 lakh per District to meet out the expenses by the survey team for hiring of vehicles at Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One thousand only) per day, for the use of survey teams and other contingencies subject to ratification by the Empowered Committee in its next meeting.

4. The Government accept the request of the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration and accord sanction for a sum of **Rs.11,00,000/- (Rupees Eleven lakhs only)** at the rate of Rs.1.00 lakhs per District to meet out the expenses by the survey team for hiring of vehicles at Rs.1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) per day for use of survey teams and other contingencies.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account within the provisions made in BE 2009-2010:-

**"2216 Housing - 80. General - 800. Other expenditure - Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan - II. State Plan - JN. Tsunami Rehabilitation works - Housing - 09. Grants in aid 03. Grants for Specific Schemes."

6. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in paragraph 4 above to the District Collectors concerned.

7. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is requested to place the above proposal before the Empowered Committee at its next meeting for ratification.
