ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have sanctioned delegation of powers to the Joint Commissioner (Relief & Rehabilitation) for incurring expenditure upto Rs.2.00 lakhs at a time for routine expenditure like hospitality, entertainment, hire charges, stationery purchase including computer stationery and office expenses (including routine expenditure such as payment of remuneration to contracts officers/ employees) to the Project Management Unit subject to availability of funds.

2. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has stated that consequent to the transfer of Thiru. A. Karthik, I.A.S., as Additional Director in Directorate of Rural Development Authority, Thiru. K. Baskaran, District Revenue Officer (Relief & Rehabilitation) is holding full additional charge of Joint Commissioner (Relief & Rehabilitation) from 19.8.2008 and looking after the duties and responsibilities of Joint Commissioner (Relief & Rehabilitation) in G.O.Ms.No.421, Revenue (NC4.1) Department, dated:8.7.08, Joint Commissioner (Relief & Rehabilitation) has been delegated with monetary powers to incur an expenditure upto Rs.2.00 lakhs in the Project Management Unit subject to availability of funds. In view of the fact that District

Revenue Officer (Relief & Rehabilitation) is looking after the duties assigned to Joint Commissioner (Relief & Rehabilitation), the powers for sanction of expenditure delegated to Joint Commissioner (Relief & Rehabilitation) may also be re-delegated to District Revenue Officer (Relief & Rehabilitation) at Project Management Unit and he may be permitted to incur an expenditure of Rs.2.00 lakhs subject to availability of funds besides attending duties and responsibilities of Joint Commissioner (Relief & Rehabilitation).

3. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration has submitted a proposal of re-delegation of monetary powers upto Rs.2.00 lakhs to District Revenue Officer (Relief & Rehabilitation) and duties and responsibilities which was hitherto assigned to Joint Commissioner (Relief & Rehabilitation) and to ratify the action of District Revenue Officer (Relief & Rehabilitation) in having continued to exercise the powers of Joint Commissioner (Relief & Rehabilitation) delegated in G.O.Ms.No.421, Revenue (NC4.1) Department, dated:8.7.08.

4. The Officer on Special Duty (Relief & Rehabilitation) has placed the above proposal before the Sub-Committee. The Sub - Committee has approved the proposal subject to the condition that the powers may be delegated upto Rs.1.00 lakh only and the expenditure has budget provision.

5. The Government accept the recommendation of the Sub - Committee and sanction the re-delegation of monetary powers upto **Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh only)** to District Revenue Officer (Relief & Rehabilitation) and duties and responsibilities which was hitherto assigned to Joint Commissioner (Relief & Rehabilitation) subject to the condition that **the expenditure has budget provision.** The Government also ratify the action of District Revenue Officer (Relief & Rehabilitation) in having continued to exercise the powers of Joint Commissioner (Relief & Rehabilitation) delegated in the Government Order first read above.
