TSUNAMI – Emergency Tsunami Reconstruction Project (ETRP) with World Bank assistance – Providing structure for permanent opening of Uppanar river in Nagapattinam District and Vellar river in Cuddalore District - Approved by the 15th Empowered Committee – Administrative Sanction – Orders - Issued.

ORDER:-

In the Government Order first read above and the amendment issued the Government Order second read above, the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.34.218 crores for implementing schemes under World Bank assistance, which interalia contains a provision of Rs.0.25 lakhs each towards carrying out studies for providing permanent opening of following four river bar mouths in Tamil Nadu:-

- i) Pulicate lake in Tiruvallur District.
- ii) Vellar river in Portonovo – Annankoil village of Cuddalore District.
- iii) Uppanar river in Tirumullaivasal village of Nagapattinam District.
- iv) Tamaraparani river in Punnakayal village of Thoothukudi District.

2) The Commissioner of Fisheries has sent a proposal to accord administrative sanction towards providing suitable structure for permanent opening of the following 2 river bar mouths in Tamil Nadu

under World Bank assisted Emergency Tsunami Reconstruction Project (ETRP):-

- i) Uppanar river bar mouth in Tirumullaivasal village of Nagapattinam District at a cost of Rs.520.28 lakh.
- ii) Vellar river bar mouth in Portonovo – Annankoil village of Cuddalore District at a cost of Rs.1024.00 lakhs.

3) The Commissioner of Fisheries has stated that, as per the instructions of Empowered Committee during its meeting held on 5.10.2005, and as per World Bank guidelines, detailed studies were carried out and Detailed Project Report was prepared for this project by the consultancy services M/s Water and Power Consultancy Services Ltd., Gurgaon. Based on the Detailed Project report furnished by the Consultancy service provider, cost estimate was finalized at a cost as follows:-

4) The Officer on Special Duty (Relief and Rehabilitation) and Project Director (ETRP and TEAP) has placed the above proposal before the Empowered Committee meeting held on 23.3.2009. The Empowered Committee has approved the proposal.

5) The Government after careful consideration, accept the proposal of the Commissioner of Fisheries as approved by the 15th Empowered Committee and accord administrative sanction for a total sum of **Rs.1544.28 lakhs (Rupees fifteen crore, forty four lakhs and twenty eight thousand only)** for providing structure viz., Construction of Groyne, Approach Road and dredging works towards permanent opening of the two river bar mouth in Tamil Nadu mentioned below under World Bank funded Emergency Tsunami Reconstruction Project (ETRP):-

- i) Uppanar river bar mouth in Tirumullaivasal village of Nagapattinam District at a cost of **Rs.520.28 lakhs (Rupees Five crore twenty lakhs and twenty eight thousand only)**.
- ii) Vellar river bar mouth in Portonovo – Annankoil village of Cuddalore District at a cost of **Rs.1024.00 lakhs (Rupees Ten crore and twenty four lakhs only)**.

The Government direct the Commissioner of Fisheries for calling tenders by following the World Bank procedures and to obtain specific clearance from World Bank before the execution of the work.

6) The Commissioner of Fisheries shall submit separate proposals to Government, for the financial sanction and actual drawal of the sanctioned amount after completing the necessary preliminary works like getting clearance from the World Bank, calling Express of Interest, Revised Procurement Plan, Tenders finalization etc., as laid down by the World Bank and in consultation with the Project Director (ETRP / TEAP).

7) The expenditure sanctioned in Paragraph 5 above for shall be debited to the following head of account:-

Fishing harbour and landing facilities – II
State Plan – Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year**

**Plan – QA. Works under Emergency Tsunami Reconstruction Project (ETRP) with assistance from World Bank – Fisheries – 16. Major Works."
