ORDER:-

The Officer on Special Duty (Relief & Rehabilitation) has placed a proposal of appointment of consultancy firm for undertaking Benefit Monitoring and Evaluation on the Rehabilitation and Reconstruction works in the Tsunami affected areas of Tamil Nadu at a cost of Rs.33.00 lakhs before the 15th Empowered Committee meeting held on 23.3.09.

2. The Empowered Committee has approved the above proposal with the condition that the cost should be pruned down and get it approved by the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration in consultation with the Finance Department.

3. The Officer on Special Duty (Relief & Rehabilitation) has stated that request for proposals documents was sent to 4 Research Institutions inviting technical and financial proposals for undertaking the Benefit Monitoring and Evaluation study. Among the 4 firms one M/s. Madras School of Social Work was selected as a Consulting Firm for undertaking the above study. After negotiations the Consulting Firm agreed to take up the study at a cost of Rs.4.99 lakhs. Asian Development Bank has also given its approval in appointing M/s. Madras School of Social Work for undertaking the above study.

Finance Department has given its concurrence for appointment of M/s. Madras School of Social Works to take up the Benefit Monitoring and Evaluation study at a cost of Rs.4.99 lakhs inclusive of all charges and taxes.

4. The Government after careful consideration, accept the proposal of the Officer on Special Duty (Relief & Rehabilitation) as approved by Empowered Committee and accord sanction for a sum of Rs.4,99,000/- (Rupees Four lakhs and ninety nine thousand only) to meet the expenditure towards engaging consultancy services for Benefit Monitoring and Evaluation on the Rehabilitation and Reconstruction works in the Tsunami affected areas of Tamil Nadu to be carried out by M/s. Madras School of Social Works.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

6. Necessary additional funds will be provided in the RE/FMA 2009-2010. Pending provision of such funds in RE/FMA 2009-2010, the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in paragraph 4 above as per the existing procedure and send the Statements of Expenditure, Utilisation Certificate and the Progress Reports as laid down by the Asian Development Bank to the Government / the Accountant General.
